Dr. Brown provided several major contributions to SAMHSA's guideline project, including the production of a laboratory inspection checklist and guidance document to reflect Proposed Mandatory Guidelines for Alternate Testing Matrices (hair, saliva, sweat, urine). She also evaluated point of collection drug testing (POCT) devices to determine viability of products, and designed and performed study scheme, organized data, and wrote a summary report for SAMHSA.
